What is WRC-World Radio Conference



- ✓ WRCs are organized by the International Telecommunications Union (ITU)
- ✓ Held every 4-5 years, 3-4 weeks, attended by over 3000 delegates
- ✓ It is job of WRC to review and revise the Radio Regulations, the international treaty governing the use of the radio-frequency spectrum and satellite orbits

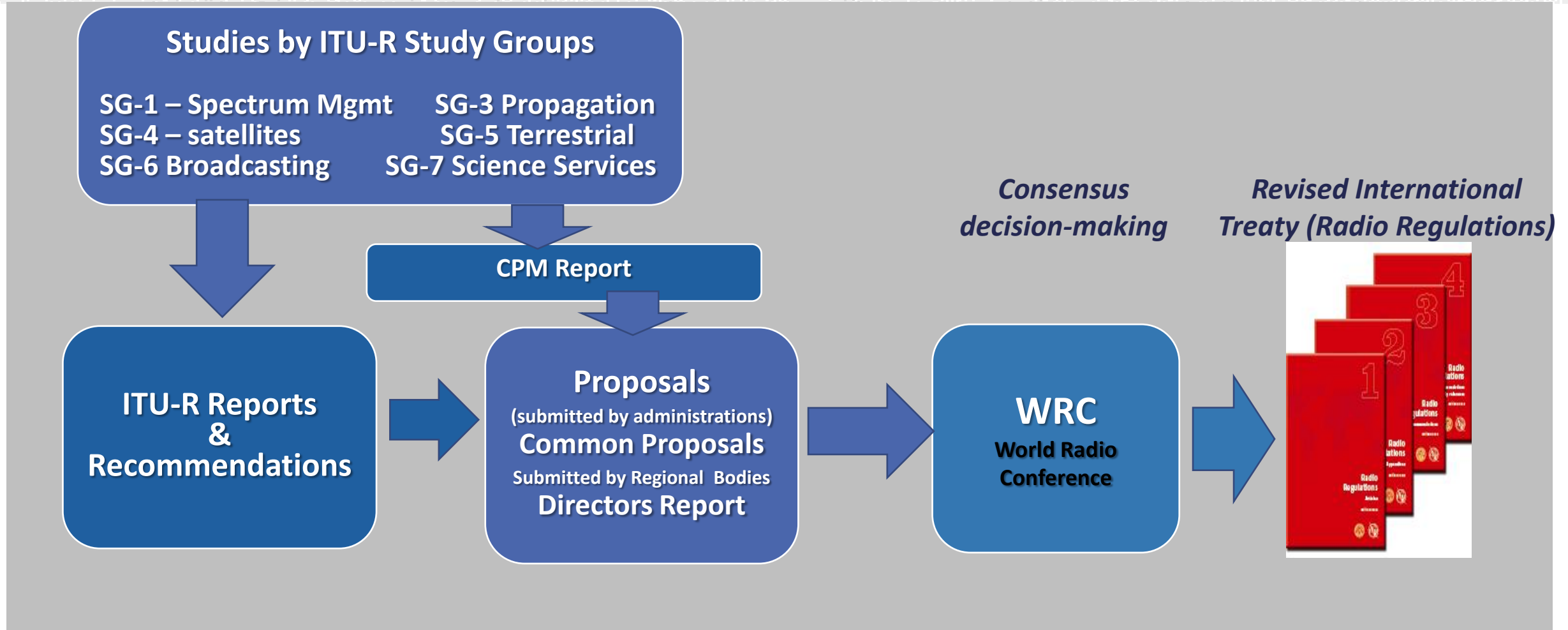

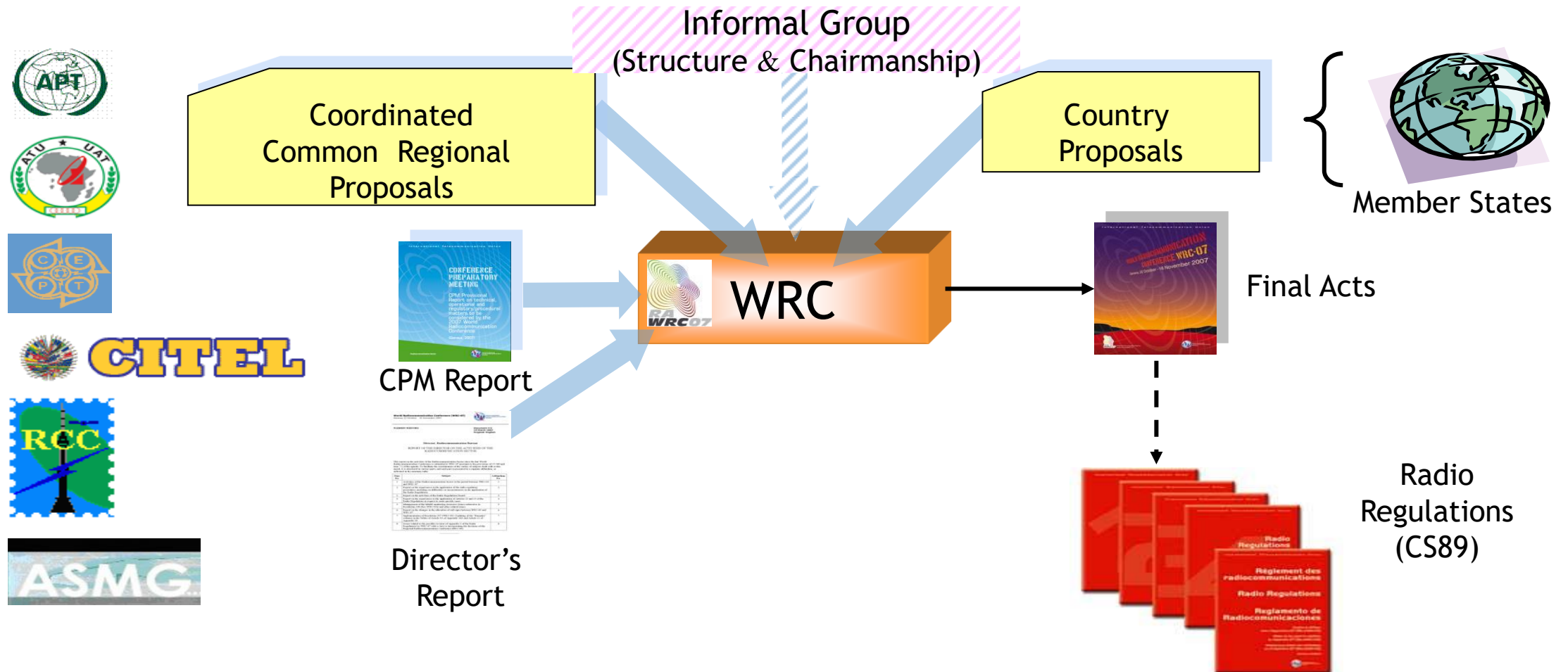

Importance of Regional bodies in WRC Process



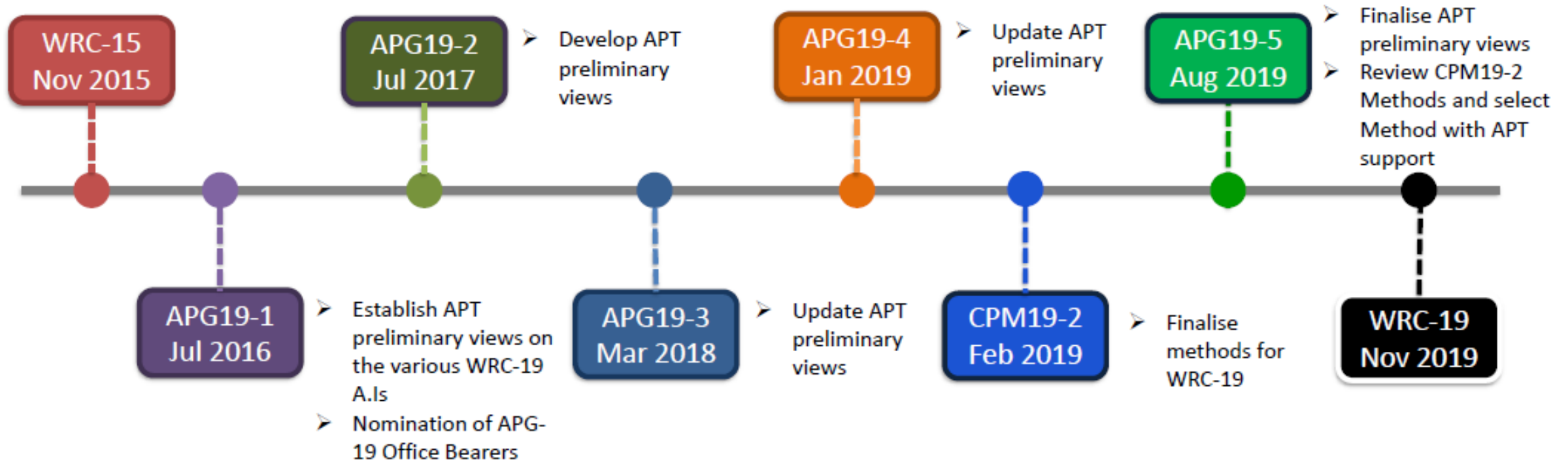
World Radio Conference 2019 (WRC-19)

- ✓ *WRC-19 will be held at Sharm-al-Sheikh In Egypt from October 28 2019 to November 22-2019*
- ✓ *It is expected to be attended by over 3500 regulators, Ministers and Wireless Industry leaders from around the world*
- ✓ *We expect a strong India participation – Estimated at over 20-30 delegates from Industry and government*
- ✓ *The final Preparatory meeting for the conference will be held in Geneva, Switzerland from 18-28 February 2019 which will finalize the CPM report.*
- ✓ *The Asia pacific Telecommunity will hold it's 4th Preparatory meeting in Busan Korea from 7th to 12th January 2019 to update APT preliminary views and also propose changes to the Draft CPM report.*

KEY ISSUES FOR WRC-19

1. **Spectrum for 5G in mm wave bands above 24 GHz band**
2. **Spectrum for Earth stations in Motion on board ships, aircrafts, trains, etc**
3. **Global Aeronautical and Maritime Distress and Safety Systems**
4. **Additional 5 GHz spectrum for WiFi**
5. **Spectrum for Met satellite and Earth exploration-satellite services in 400 MHz**
6. **Maritime mobile-satellite service allocations for VHF data exchange systems;**
7. **Spectrum needs for telemetry, tracking and command in the space operation**
8. **Spectrum requirements for high-altitude platform stations**

Structure of the CPM report to WRC-19

CPM Report Includes summary of studies and methods to resolve each of the 30 agenda items

CPM Report is structured in six chapters as below

6. General issues	2, 4, 9.1 (9.1.6, 9.1.7), 10
