Telecom Stories:

The Central Government is planning an incentive scheme to help domestic Cloud technology companies and start-ups tackle the domination of Microsoft Azure, Amazon Web Services and Google Cloud. Industry analysts have highlighted that demand for cloud continued to be resilient in emerging markets including India and Asian countries coming from new-age technology firms in these regions.



Indian scientists, engineers and academicians have acquired 100 patents for 6G technology. While speaking at the Bharat Start up summit organised by the PhD chamber of commerce, the IT and Telecom Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said that India is taking a leap in 5G technology with the fastest roll out of networks in the world. He also emphasised that India has become USD 3.5 Trillion and it can become the world's largest economy with transformation across governance and infrastructure.

IT hardware manufacturers such as Foxconn, HP and Dixon Technologies have urged the government to drop the fresh investment clause proposed in the revised production-linked incentive (PLI) scheme being prepared for the industry. The first version of the scheme had failed to take off, with only two-three companies out of the eligible 14 expected to meet their first-year targets.
