

Telecom Stories:

The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) is not considering any reduction in license fee of telecom operators, rejecting repeated demands from the industry and recommendation from the TRAI. The DoT has also rejected the Trai's recommendations on reducing the universal services obligation (USO) levy to 3% from 5%, as that would also lead to a revenue loss.

The Prime Minister, Narendra Modi Inaugurated 91 new 100W FM transmitters via Video Conferencing. The Inauguration will give a further boost to radio connectivity in the country. The Prime Minister underlined that the inauguration of the 91 FM transmitters forwards the policies of the government that gives preference to the underprivileged who have been deprived of this facility.

The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (Meity) has called the second round of pre-drafting consultations with the industry stakeholders and policy experts on the principles of the upcoming Digital India Act (DIA). The Ministry has been working on a Draft Digital India bill to replace digital law information Technology Act (IT) 2000 for addressing changing challenges created by the modern-day internet.
