

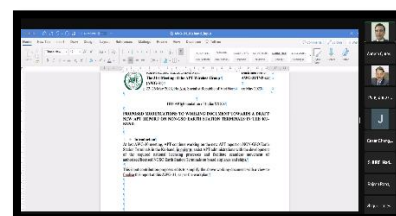

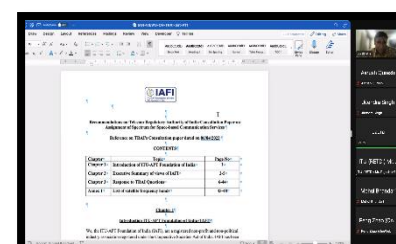

WhatsApp has expressed gratitude towards IT and Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw for acknowledging the Meta-owned messaging app’s “continuous commitment to user safety in India”. This comes after several WhatsApp users were bombarded with spam and international calls and messages. MoS IT Rajeev Chandrashekar asked the platform to explain how these spammers were getting access to the WhatsApp numbers. Vaishnaw also launched the Sanchar Sathi Portal on the occasion of WTISD. This portal aims at helping users track their lost and stolen phones.
