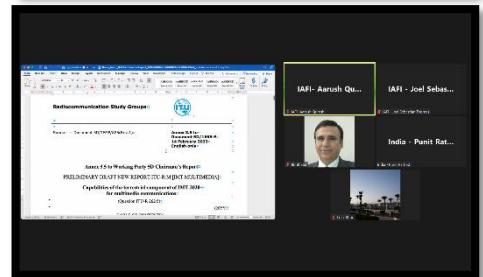
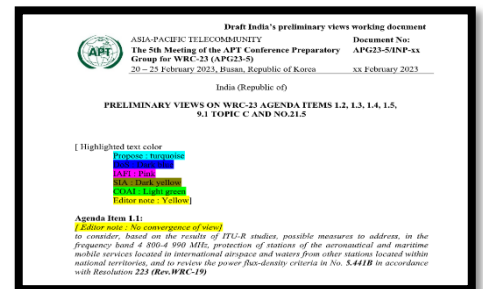

Fourth NPC WG-1 meeting for contribution to WRC-23:

Asia-Pacific Telecommunity (APT) has invited contributions for APG-6 meetings from administrations on various WRC-23 Agenda items and issues related to RA-23. IAFI has submitted its views on agenda items of Fixed, Mobile and Broadcasting issues (1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 1.4, 1.5, 9.1 (c), Article 21.5) to the NPC meeting on 30th May 2023.

Telecom Stories:

After satellite spectrum, the telecom industry stands divided over the allocation of backhaul airwaves. While older telcos – Bharti Airtel and Vodafone Idea – want allocation on an administrative basis or without auction to continue. Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (Trai) has been conducting informal meeting with the telcos ahead of a consultation paper on the allocation of backhaul E and V spectrum bands.



The International Telecommunication Union (ITU) has appointed India's Department of Telecommunications (DoT) official, as the ITU Area Representative for Southeast Asia and Timor Leste, Indonesia. Mr. Kishore Babu commenced his role as ITU Area Representative for Southeast Asia and Timor Leste on 1st June 2023. Babu has over 30 years of experience in various leadership positions in telecommunications policy development programs and projects; international relations; stakeholder engagement with national and international entities.



State-run telecom research body CDoT along with Indian software major Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) has developed the 4G/5G stack. Vaishnav had earlier said that India was in talks with 18 countries across the world that are keen to implement the 4G-5G technology stack. The 5G rollout has been one of the fastest roll out in the world with one site installed.
