### About the Program

The World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly (WTSA) is held every four years and it defines the next period of study for ITU-T. WTSA-24 is slated to take place from 15th to 24th October 2024 in New Delhi, India. The event is being hosted by the Department of Telecommunications, Govt. of India and Telecom Engineering Centre (TEC) is main focal point for coordination and compilation of various suggestions and inputs from India and aligning with Asia-Pacific Telecommunity (APT) for WTSA 24.

As a run up to the October event, IAFI is organising the first Preparatory Workshop for WTSA24 on January 10, 2024. Since WTSA serves as a critical platform for setting the agenda and shaping the future of international telecommunication standards, the workshop proposes to deliberate and steer dialogue between various stake holders on several areas and resolutions for researchers, startups and industry including Bridging the Standardization Gap between developing and developed countries, and the role of Open source in the ITU Telecommunication Standardization Sector. The inputs gathered will be compiled and suggestions will be submitted to DOT/ TEC/APT.



#### **About the Program**

Satellite communication services and the space industry at large offers a huge market potential in India with capability of attracting billions of Dollars as FDI, generating huge employment, and enhancing GDP growth, apart from initiating greater innovation and R&D. While the government has taken steps with fresh policy initiatives and reforms like unlocking the space sector to private players, and its decision to hold satellite spectrum auction soon which is highly encouraging for the industry, however, challenges remain that require to be addressed especially in the area of spectrum licencing, allocation and pricing. For promoting deliberation and discussion on these issues IAFI is hosting a national conference on Satcom spectrum opportunities and challenges on 18 th April 2024.
